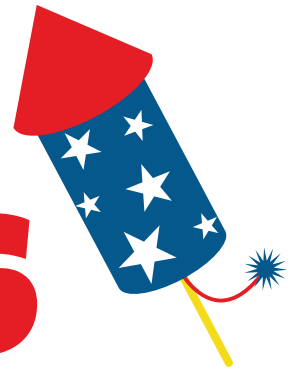


FIREWORKS SAFETY TIPS



BEFORE THE SHOOT

Know the laws.

Check the laws in your jurisdiction and make sure it's legal to shoot fireworks.

Plan ahead.

Choose an open outside area with no obstructions, and pick a day with little wind.

Prep the crowd.

Spectators should stay a safe distance away from shooting area (min. 500 feet).

SAFETY TOOLS

- Water source (garden hose, fire extinguisher or bucket of water)
- Safety glasses
- Close-toed shoes
- Bricks (or stakes and duct tape) to brace multi-shot cakes
- Sober adult shooter
- Instant-on torch, lighter, or punk sticks
- First aid kit

SHOOTING CHECKLIST

- Read and follow the label directions on each item.
- Place item on a hard, flat outdoor surface.
- Brace multi-shot cakes to prevent tip-over.
- Do not place any part of your body over a firework.
- Light one fuse at a time and stand back.
- Never attempt to re-light a firework that doesn't go off.
- Let items cool overnight or soak in water before disposing.
